



OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM POLICY of DALEKOVOD j.s.c. AND ASSOCIATED COMPANIES

The scope of occupational health and safety management systems is the manufacture, sales, construction, and design of electric power transmission lines and electric power-stations up to 750 kV, suspension and jointing equipment, railway facilities, roads, buildings, sports facilities, lighting, telecommunications lines and poles, lighting poles and halls, steel and other load-bearing structures, equipment of civil engineering and electric installations, and the provision of anti-corrosive metal protection.
